

Lean-On's Cookie Policy

What data do we collect?

At lean-on.com, we only collect basic behavioral data about your visits to our website in order to provide you with the best possible user experience and for the purpose of compiling statistics.

Data that we collect on your behavior comes from the following sources:

Cookies

A cookie is a small data file which is used to register a user's behavior on a network, and which is stored locally with the user (on the user's hard drive). This means that when the user returns to the website, the server (lean-on.com) will know if the user is a first-time user or a recurring user, and it will also know for how long the user has been active on the website.

Cookies are used on lean-on.com for the purpose of optimizing the website and its functionality, hence, to make the visit as convenient as possible for you.

You can delete cookies at any time by selecting the menu option: 'Tools' > 'Internet Settings' > 'Delete Cookies'.

Device and log information

We collect device-specific data regarding your operating system, whether or not you are using a PC or a mobile device, etc. We also log your IP address and search queries.

Location data

When you use lean-on.com, we collect information on your geographic location based on your IP address.

How do we use the data we collect?

We use the data collected exclusively for the purpose of giving you the best possible experience when visiting lean-on.com and in order to compile statistics.

Statistics are collected and compiled using Google Analytics and made available to Lean-On A/S. As a data processor, Google is subject to the data protection rules set out by the GDPR.

None of the data collected are sold, shared or transferred to third parties.

We always ask for consent before using your data for any purpose other than those set out in the present cookie policy.
